- 4. Gentile Nations Matthew 25:31-32, 41
- 5. Nation of Israel Ezekiel 20:35
- 6. Great White Throne Judgment Revelation 20:11-15
- 7. Angels, fallen & 'good ones' Isaiah 24:21-22, II Peter 2:4, Jude 6, I Corinthians 6:1-3

## The Judgment Seat of Christ - "Bema" Seat

Romans 14:10-12, I Corinthians 3:10-15, I Corinthians 4:1-5, II Corinthians 5:10

When? = after the Rapture - Luke 14:14

Where? = in heaven (already brought up by Rapture - I Thess. 4 & I Cor. 15

Who will be judged? = all Christians (AD 33-Rapture) - I Thessalonians 4:16

Who will be doing the judging? = Jesus - John 5:22

Why? = prepare us for the wedding - Ephesians 5:27, Revelation 19:6-10

What? = our works on earth – II Corinthians 5:10

How? = awarding of 5 possible crowns – listed below

## The 5 Crowns awarded at the Judgment Seat of Christ - "Stephanos" vs. "Diademos"

1. Crown of Life – James 1:12

Crown awarded to those who persevere through hard times and 'keep the faith,' especially to those who are martyred for their faith

2. Crown of Righteousness – II Timothy 4:7-8

Crown awarded to those who long for Jesus' return to the point that they are heavenly focused in the way that they live

3. Victor's Crown – I Corinthians 9:24-27

Crown awarded to those who are willing to die to their flesh, example of overeating, lusting, swallowing pride, submission to authority etc

4. Crown of Glory – I Peter 5:1-4

Crown awarded to those who teach & preach faithfully the Word of God to help people grow in their faith, regardless of opposition

5. Crown of Rejoicing – I Thessalonians 2:19-20

Crown awarded to those who witness to others about Jesus, soul winner's crown, missionary-minded crown
