8. Openness means we won't try to restrict the ways God wants to work in us; we are to what God wants to do.
9. Intimacy with is Him more than we know anyone else.
10. Insight means the ability to the true meaning with the help of the Holy Spirit.
11. Obedience means actively obeying; toto obey.
